Overview

Co-Curricular Activities (CCAs) and External Curricular Activities (ECAs) are an important part of our school community. These activities provide opportunities for students to participate in team-based sports, discover new passions, develop social skills, play together and most importantly, have fun!

CCAs are run by Chatsworth teachers & teaching assistants for students in Years 1 to 6. ECAs are run by external providers who are contracted to provide their programme on campus for Primary students from Years 1 to 6.

CCAs can take place at lunch time from 12:30 - 1:30 or after school (excluding Wednesdays due to staff meetings) from 3:45-4:30pm.

Please collect your children at **4:30pm** from the canteen. Parents/guardians must arrange for prompt pick-up when the CCA or ECA ends. Students in Years 4 - 6 may travel home alone. Students in Years 3 and below must be accompanied. There are no usual school buses at this time.

In the case of bad weather, outdoor CCAs will not be cancelled, CCA teachers will conduct the CCA indoors.
