Dear Secondary Parents, Guardians, Teachers, and Students,

Re: SECONDARY Spirit week - Including a Fundraising Activity for Blue Dragon

The Secondary student council is happy to announce that spirit week 2018 will be taking place from the 6th to 12th of December!

Every year, spirit week aims to boost overall school spirit and morale among secondary students, while encouraging them to be creative and hopefully have some fun. This year, spirit week will take place on the last five days of school before winter break from the 6th to 12th of December and students are encouraged to come to school dressed up in clothes that correspond to the themes listed below:

- **Thursday, 6th December 2018 - Throw it together Thursday** - Students are encouraged to come in clothes that have just been 'thrown together', this could include clashing patterns/colours or pyjamas.
- **Friday, 7th December 2018 - Blue dragon Friday** - This is the only day where students **will have to pay \$2** in order to dress up in their own clothes and all donations will go to the Blue Dragon children's foundation that helps street kids, kids with disabilities and rescues kids from slavery and human trafficking in Vietnam. - **Monday, 10th December 2018 - Meme Monday** - Students are encouraged to come dressed up as their favourite meme. This can be done individually, in groups or in pairs.
- **Tuesday, 11th December 2018 House shirt** - Students are encouraged to come in their house shirts as the annual spirit rally will be taking place and everyone will be sitting in their houses during the course of the day.
- **-Wednesday, 12th December 2018 - Festival Wednesday** - Students are encouraged to come dressed to celebrate the start of winter vacation in a very festive way!! Ugly sweaters, reindeer ears, lights, etc.

We ask students to be respectful in the manner in which they dress. If students are dressed inappropriately or have not paid their \$2 on the 7th of December, they will be subject to the schools uniform policy and could be sent home immediately to change before they can come back to school.
