Dear Parents, Guardians, Teachers, and Students,

Re: Student Council Valentine's Day Grams and Free Dress Day.

Once again, February, the month of love and appreciation has come around. As per tradition, Student Council will be selling Valentine's Day grams as a fundraiser, starting on the 11th of February through the 13th of February. The grams will be sold at lunch-time from 1:00-1:45 in the Nest - cash only. All placed deliveries will be delivered to their respective recipients on the 14th of February.

One flower or two chocolates would be \$2. A combo of chocolates and a flower will be \$4. A singing telegram and chocolate/rose (either one) will be \$5. A bouquet of 6 flowers will be \$10 dollars. Custom notes will also be provided for items sold. Orders can be placed through at the Stuco booth, during lunch. Students will have to pay in cash using only bills (ie no coins). Chocolates are allergy free, containing no nuts, individually wrapped, and purchased from a store.

On Thursday, February 14th, STUCO will be sponsoring a free dress day encouraging all students to wear festive outfits.

These will be "free dress" days on which all secondary students are encouraged to wear non-uniform clothes. Students will have to pay \$2 cash (ie no coins) in order to come in their own clothing. The money will be collected by STUCO members in the mornings during homeroom time, a student must have the \$2 at this time and will not be permitted to pay at later instances during the day. Please be aware we can only accept notes and cannot take coins. Managing coins has become impractical over the past few years and all fundraising efforts are now cash-only. We ask students to be respectful in the manner in which they dress. This means no revealing tops/spaghetti strap tops and shorts must be of appropriate length. Students must also not wear sandals or flip-flop type shoes (i.e. shoes must fully cover the feet). If students are dressed inappropriately or have not paid their \$2, they will be sent home to change by their homeroom teachers. Please make sure all students are dressed appropriately prior to arriving at school and we refer you to our section on "General Appearance" in the Student Handbook for further guidance.

The purpose of this fundraiser is to raise funds for the Chatsworth Student Council to create great even more quality events in the future.
