Dear DP Visual Art students, parents/guardians,

The IB DP Visual Arts course requires students to develop a deep understanding of the visual arts in context. Students are required to view artworks first hand to deepen their understanding of theoretical practice, art-making practice and curatorial practice. One of the external assessment items is a comparative essay looking at artwork they have viewed first hand.

With this in mind, we have two wonderful opportunities to visit world-class exhibitions in January 2020. The first is S.E.A.Focus - A visual art event held at the Gillman Barracks. This is the second time it has been hosted here in Singapore and will bring together a curated selection of galleries from across the wider Southeast Asia region, including Jakarta, Makati City, Kuala Lumpur, Bangkok and Hanoi, as well as Beijing, Berlin, Brisbane, New York and Seoul. Some of our students visited this one last year and found it the most beneficial event for their visual Art studies.

The second exhibition is called 'Disturbing Narratives' and is currently on show at the Parkview Museum in Parkview Square. It presents over 30 artists from Europe, Asia, Africa and North & South America who are working with completely different visual languages and media: spanning painting, drawing, photography, video, sculpture and installation.

We have arranged these excursions to be the least disruptive on their DP studies and will also involve some after school time for the students. There will be no cost to the students.
