As you are no doubt aware your sons/daughters have been extremely busy this last term with their E-Portfolio tasks in all the Arts subjects (Drama, Music and Visual Art). This letter is to inform you that MYP 5 students will be required on campus for both **Monday 16th** and **Tuesday 17th March, from 9.00am - 3.35pm**. These are the scheduled Parent-Teacher-Student Conference dates. These days are a chance for students to put the last polish on their assessment pieces and also to complete the commentary/reflection which is Task 4.

The IB has strict deadlines that we must adhere to, so students need to work within the time constraints and develop their own time management skills. The e-Portfolio includes:

- an investigation into the work of master artists, theorists and practitioners
- the application of creative-thinking behaviours to generate artistic intentions
- acquiring, developing and applying skills and techniques while exploring artistic ideas
- applying the outcomes of their investigation in the development of their own work
- critical appreciation of the work of others
- critical evaluation

Students will also have an appointed time for their Language orals which will also take place on these days.
