This year, students in Year 7 will be presenting in the first ever **Living Lit** book fair. This inaugural event will be part of Chatsworth's annual Book Week celebration, which will be held from 6th-9th April this year with the theme "*Bring Books to Life.*"

The book fair projects will be presented on 7th April 2020 from 2:45-3:30 p.m. in 4 separate exhibition spaces on campus. Your children have been working hard this semester to read books independently and to develop a creative visual project to demonstrate their understanding of their selected books.

Students will also be using their projects to compete for four different in-school awards:

**Most Creative Presentation:** The student presentation that provides the most original way to share the content of the book.

**Best Visual Presentation:** The student presentation that is most artistically beautiful and attracts and engages the audience.

**Best Response to Mother Tongue Literature:** This category is for students who read in a language other than English. The award goes to the student presentation that creates the most informative and engaging presentation about a Mother Tongue book for an English-speaking audience who might otherwise not be able to enjoy this book.

**Most Inspiring Presentation:** The student whose presentation inspires the most audience members to want to read that book.

Due to current COVID-19 restrictions, we are unfortunately unable to invite families to attend the fair this year. However, please take some time to talk about this project with your child, and let students share their love for reading with you.
