Dear Parents, Guardians, Teachers, and Students,

RE: Student Council: Halloween Week

As part of the various Student council events that will take place this year, there will be a fun packed week full of Halloween related activities organized by Chatsworth's Student Council. This week will take place from the 29th of October to the 1st of November.

Week Agenda:

Tuesday: Guess the amount of Jelly Beans in the Jar and What's in the box challenge, which will be held at lunch. Winners will be awarded a prize!

Wednesday: Halloween themed bake sale (e.g Cakes, Cookies, Muffins). This will be sold to only secondary students. The goods will be priced at \$2-4. We would greatly appreciate the support of all students at our bake sale. As such parents/guardians may need to send students to school with additional money in order to buy from the bake sale. **Please be aware that we can only accept notes we cannot take coins.** Managing coins has become impractical over the past few years and all fundraising efforts are now cash-only.

We will try our best to consider the allergy and/or dietary requirement (e.g. nut allergies, gluten allergy, sugar allergies, lactose intolerance, etc.) but we cannot guarantee that the goods will be 100% free from allergen ingredients. We will try to indicate the ingredients and potential allergies for each food item.

Thursday: Halloween costume Competition. The costume contest will take place at lunch and will be judged according to three sections: Lower secondary (Y7 - Y9), upper secondary (Y10 - Y13), and teachers/staff. The categories for this competition will be; best single, best double and best group (consisting of at least 3 people per group). This event is **FREE!**

We ask students to be respectful in the manner in which they dress. This means no revealing tops/spaghetti strap tops or leggings and shorts must be of appropriate length. **Students should also not wear sandals or flip-flops type shoes** (i.e. shoes must fully cover the feet). If students are dressed inappropriately they will be subject to our uniform policy and could be sent home immediately to change before they can come back to school. Please make sure all students are dressed appropriately prior to arriving at school and we



refer you to our section on “General Appearance” in the Student Handbook for further guidance. Note: Students participating in PHE those mornings will need to be in full PHE uniform before the homeroom period begins.

Friday: Movie night. A separate email will be sent out as permission slips are needed.
