Dear Parents/Guardians in Years 7-11,

Re: MYP Middle Years Child Protection Curriculum Outline of Schedule and Topics

I am writing to update you about the Keeping Safe: Child Protection Curriculum (KS:CPC) that your child/children will be learning throughout the year. We have mapped out our timeline for MYP Y7-10 using the Middle Years program and Y11 using the Senior Years program.

The two KS:CPC Themes of “We all have the right to be safe” and “We can help ourselves be safe talking to people we trust,” are explored through four Focus Areas. The four KS:CPC Focus Areas will have lessons in the following timelines (timelines might be adjusted slightly if more time is required or due to unforeseen circumstances).

- **Focus Area 1: The right to be safe**

Lesson 1: Risk-taking and emergencies - Sept 13th

- **Focus Area 3: Recognising and reporting abuse**

Lesson 2: Recognizing Abuse - Sept 24th (Y8 Sept 27th)

Lesson 2: Network Review & Community support - Oct 8th

- **Focus Area 2: Relationships**

Lesson 1: Rights & responsibilities in close relationships; Identity & Relationships - Dec 5th

Lesson 2: Power in Relationships & Power & Gender - Dec 10th

Lesson 3: Trust and Networks - Jan 7th
